Iowa/Illini Cup

The Iowa flag is flying already! Can Illinois finally take over? This Ryder Cup team event pits Iowa fans against Illinois fans.

Date: October 14th-8:30 Shot-Gun

Entry Fee: \$20 cash per player. Does not include cart.

Format: Team Match Play-You will be paired with a partner from your team and will play 1 best net ball out of two against another twosome from the other team.

Points: If you win your 18-hole match you will receive 1 point. If there is a tie you and the opposing team will receive .50 points.

Handicap: 100% of your individual handicap will be used. Handicap strokes will be off the low handicap player in your match. Gold handicap players will have three strokes deducted from their handicap.

Tees: You will either be playing from the white or gold tees.

Tie: In the event of tie at the completion of the matches we will have a sudden death playoff. Each captain will choose three 2-man teams to compete in a playoff on hole #18. The team who scores the most points in the 3 matches is deemed the overall champion.

What's at stake? Bragging rights are a guarantee. You will be playing for all the cash! Winner take all.

Jeremy's Revenge

Date: October 28th-9:00am shotgun

Entry Fee: \$25.00 cash and includes lunch. Fee does not include cart.

Format: 2-person Scramble, pick your own partner. All team members tee off and then select the best positioned shot. Then all team members play their shots from the position selected. This format is repeated until the ball is holed out. You can play your ball within 1 foot of the selected ball. When you get to the green you must play your ball 6 inches of the selected ball. Your ball must be played in the original conditions of the selected ball; rough, bunker, etc.

Tees: You will be playing the white, gold or red tees.

Drive Requirements: 2 drives per player per nine.

Handicaps: 35% of the A player handicap and 17% of the B player handicap.

Flights: We will have two flights; gross and net. The flights will be configured at the end of play.

Skins: There will be an option \$10 team gross skins game.

Prizes: In lieu of awards we will pay out cash to the top place winners in each flight.

Playoff for Ties: In the event of ties for first place winners in each flight, there will be a sudden death playoff, starting on hole #18.



Out On The Course

The 2017 golf season is winding down and what a great season it was. The membership numbers have been strong, course has been in great shape all year, and the staff has once again been awesome. We still have some great weather to look forward to and a couple fun events to participate in so don't put your clubs away too soon.

The aerification on greens and tees has just been finished and recovering nicely. The busy September we had forced us to aerify late this year so we made smaller holes for less disruption of play and quicker recovery times. The greens will be slow for a while with raised cutting heights to aid in recovery. The fairways will not be aerified this year and only spiked with solid knives so this will be hardly noticeable. We have no major course changes

in the works for this year other than some small bunker improvements if weather allows.

I am excited to say we are getting all new windows in the lounge this fall. The old original windows have been in place for way too long and are in need of replacement. We will be going with large picture windows similar to what was put in the dining room. We will also be incorporating floor to ceiling bi-fold doors on the west end that will open up about 13' wide at that end of the lounge to create a great indoor/outdoor feel on nice summer days. We will also be getting blinds for that room as well once the install is complete.

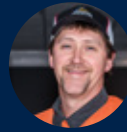
